ABSTRACT

This study presents a selected annotated bibliography of scholarly publications produced by Yobe State University faculties and researchers, in twenty-three (23) peer-reviewed journals (Al-Mugaddimah, Innovative Journal of Management and Science Education(IJMSE), International Journal of Management and Social Sciences(IJMSS), International Journal of Research and Development Studies(IJRDS), Innovative Journal of Social Science, Arts and Management (IJSSAM), International Journal of Research in Library Science (IJRLS), International Journal of Research and Sustainable Development (IJRSD), International Journal of Computer Science and Information Technology Research (IJCSITR), Jewel Journal of Librarianship (JJL), Ambrose Alli University Communicate: Journal of Information Science(AAUECJIS), Yobe Journal of Economics(YOJE), Yobe Journal of Management Innovations (YOJMI), Yobe Journal of Economics (YOJE), Yobe Journal of Environmental and Development (YJED), and Yobe State University Law Review, (YSLR).) between 2017 and 2024. The annotated bibliography provides a systematic and detailed overview of the research output of Yobe State University faculties, covering various disciplines and fields of study. The study employed bibliometric analysis, utilizing forty-five (145) reputable journals in related fields as instruments for data collection. A total of one hundred and forty-five (145) articles published within the specified timeframe were meticulously examined, analysed, and annotated. The annotated bibliography offers concise summaries and evaluations of each source, highlighting their research themes, methodologies, findings, and contributions to the existing body of knowledge. The findings of this study reveal the research strengths and gaps of Yobe State University faculties, indicate that three (3) authors has more publication within the year range of this study, journal of Al-Mugaddimah Published more articles, and faculty of Arts has the most articles. The research themes are more dominant in social science and arts and education with topics related to environmental development and survey research method was pupillary used. Based on the analysis, recommendations were provided for university administrators, faculty members, and researchers to improve the research ecosystem, foster a culture of research excellence, and promote knowledge sharing and collaboration. These recommendations include strategies for enhancing research capacity, improving publication quality, and increasing the visibility and impact of research output. This selected annotated bibliography serves as a valuable resource for researchers, academics, and practitioners seeking to understand the research landscape of Yobe State University faculties and identify potential areas for collaboration and knowledge sharing. The study contributes to the growing body of literature on African universities and their research output, providing insights into the challenges and opportunities facing these institutions.

INTRODUCTION

An annotated bibliography is a formatted list of researched sources that includes a brief evaluation of each source, or a reference list that comprises of brief summary and evaluation of sources. On the other hand, is a list of citations followed by a brief summary or analysis of reference sources, which gives information about the relevance and quality of the sources through description or

interpretation of the source cited. These descriptive paragraphs, or annotations, are usually less than one hundred and forty-five (145) words in length and are meant to demonstrate the accuracy, quality, and relevance of the sources in relation to the topic being researched. Unlike abstracts, which are purely descriptive summaries, annotations not only summarize the information after each work cited or each reference, but they also analyse the content's perspective, credibility, and relevance, (Aunkst, and Todd, K. 2014).

Composing an annotated bibliography, therefore, encourages the researcher to critically examine each of his or her sources for central themes, intended audience, the authority and background of the author, and areas in which the text supports, contradicts, or illuminates the research topic. This process of critical thinking also helps the writer clarify the focus of the research topic as he or she evaluates and refines a list of sources to support a strong thesis. The citation style used in an annotated bibliography should be consistent with the style used in the rest of the research paper. Usually, this is either MLA or APA format but may vary according to instructors' preferences. (American Psychological Association, 2010).

Yobe State University, located in the heart of North-Easter Nigeria, since its inception in 2006, the university has fostered a vibrant community of scholars dedicated to advancing knowledge and addressing the complex challenges facing our globalized world. With a growing community of researchers and scholars, the university has made significant contributions to various fields of study, (community analysis, 2024).

Significance of the study

Annotations assist researchers in creating reference lists for their topics by summarizing the sources. They enable researchers to engage critically with the topics, facilitating a deeper understanding of the subject matter and the sources themselves. This work will assist researchers in organizing and evaluating research sources and also in enhancing critical thinking, and academic integrity. This structured format allows individuals to keep track of relevant information and assess how each source contributes to their research topic, and enhances understanding by summarizing and evaluating the sources, scholars gain a deeper understanding of the material, how it relates to their work, and how various perspectives and arguments contribute to their research area. Finally, the study promotes academic integrity by documenting sources and providing evaluations, it ensures proper credit is given to original authors and helps avoid plagiarism.

Purpose

This annotated bibliography aims to provide a selected overview of some of the scholarly publications by Yobe State University faculties, and researchers. It showcases the university's research output, reflecting the institution's commitment to intellectual inquiry, critical thinking, and interdisciplinary collaboration. Spanning in social and management sciences, arts, law and education, this selected compilation highlights the university's research strengths and expertise. The one hundred and forty-five (145) entries included in this bibliography represent a curated selection of peer-reviewed articles published in 2017 to 2024. Each annotation provides the article's title, the author, the journal title, and year of publication.

Scope and Organization of the Bibliography

The bibliography covers published articles from the 2017 to 2024 articles from twenty-three (23) journals. Each publication is organized by faculty, author, title, and publication year.

METHODOLOGY

A bibliometric analysis is used, it involves analysing the publication data, such as authors, titles, the journal titles, year of publication, Volumes, and ISSN numbers, to identify trends, patterns and correlations. Data were analyses using citation analysis techniques, it analyse the citation pattern

to identify influential authors, articles, and journals. Citation management software of Mendeley was used as tools in arranging the information, and consideration of data quality was done to ensure data accuracy and reliability. Sources were gathered from university repositories, faculty curriculum vitae, and library catalogues.

LIMITATIONS

Data were limited to This bibliography may not be exhaustive due to accessibility limitations, publication lags, and limited page limitation, it is limited to published articles of one hundred and forty-five (145) from the 2017 to 2024 articles from fifteen (15) journals, each article is published by staff of Yobe State University.

Step-by-Step for Writing an Annotated Bibliography

The creation of an annotated bibliography is a three-step process. It starts with evaluating sources, writing annotation for each different source, and finally the citation style. (American Psychological Association, 2010)

Step 1: Analysis of Sources

When it comes to an annotated bibliography there is the need to critically look at the topic's sources and research, the author and the date of the study. Since new thoughts and literary movements are happening all the time, make sure the analysis and opinions are relevant to topic and current times. In addition to these, the publisher or journal where the research is found is distinguished and reviewed by professionals in the field. Research by an unknown or un-reputable journal will not make a good source for any arguments or analysis. Critically analysis of all these different areas helps evaluate if the source is credible and helpful.

Step 2: Create Your Annotations

In creating annotations, there are different ways depending on intent. The ways include descriptive/indicative, informative/summary, evaluation or a combination of all three.

- **i. Indicative/Descriptive Annotations-** Descriptive or indicative annotations describe the source, by giving a quick summary of the source and argument and describe the main points and even chapters within the source.
 - **Example-** Makintami, A. I. Essential role of libraries in education: a study on the impact of library resources and services on student achievement and academic routine. Yobe journal of educational studies (YOJES), 2024.Vol. 1. No. 1 June, 2024. Pp. 62-77. ISSN: 1595-5338. This article covers the role of libraries in providing resources and services to students in academic institutions to enhance their performance.
- **ii. Informative/Summary Annotations-** Summary or informative annotations simply provide a summary of different source, by describing the main arguments or points along with the various topics covered.
 - **Example- Makintami, A. I.** Trends in library and information science: Beyond the shelves: evolving roles in contemporary librarianship, 2024. Vol. 1. Chapter three. . John Aruya Oloaigbe printing press, Pp. 108-139 ISBN: 978-978-60624-3-3. In this book, edited by Murtala Aliyu and Babangida Umar Babayi, Makintami. The author explores how the new trends in library and information science explained how the library is now providing services beyond the shelves, which can lead to significant growth. The narrative includes users, behind-the-scenes services and resources. This work is essential for understanding new library strategies that contribute to the success of librarianship
- **Evaluation Annotations-** Evaluation annotations is a further summary of the source, where there is the need to compare and contrast it, and the reliability of the information and any bias it might have.

Makintami uses strategies such as articulation, communication, translation, engagement, monitoring and controlling strategies. The author analyses the strategies to offer insights into state universities libraries management. While the fresh perspective is engaging, the work occasionally lacks depth due to its broad examination of the strategies.

iv. Combination Annotations - This Annotations combine all three types of annotations into one annotated bibliography, by describing and summarizing the work and end with an evaluation.

In this article, El-badawy and Makintami details various sustainable trends and opportunities of reference services in academic libraries, revealing asynchronous reference tools used by academic libraries were email and web forms are synchronous into chat reference such as Facebook, twitter etc. reference services has growth in popularity and successful in bridging the information gap between those in need of information and those who provide the information. This source is particularly valuable for my research as it not only summarizes current approaches but also evaluates their impact on reference services, demonstrating both their potential and limitations.

Writing Style for Annotations

There are various types of annotations you can create, and you can also employ different writing styles for those annotations. Typically, annotations follow three specific formats, depending on their length:

- Phrases: Short phrases that provide information in a quick, concise manner.
- Sentences: Complete sentences with proper punctuation and grammar. Ensure that sentences are short and to the point.
- Paragraphs: Longer annotations that can be organized into multiple paragraphs, making them effective for combination annotations.


Step 3: Annotated Bibliography Format

1. APA Example


An APA annotated bibliography is used for science and technical papers. It includes an APA citation and APA formatting for headers and title.
